Informatix Inc (IFX) would like to explain the current situation with the two software products; MicroGDS and Piranesi.

First of all, we would like to make a humble apology for being quiet about our position in relation to Informatix Software International Limited (ISIL) in the last few months. This was due to UK legal advice given to us to minimize the risks to IFX. We therefore could not take any immediate positive action relating to the ISIL business after terminating the contract.

It was a difficult decision to terminate the contract with ISIL, but it had become clear that ISIL were having financial problems. We were informed they had not paid royalties to third party technology partners and they also had not paid royalty payments to IFX for over a year.

We are currently reviewing our plans for the future of the products. However, we can tell you that we have employed the services of Brian Woodward, who many of you will know as the Technical Director of ISIL until September 2009, to put together a support and development organization in the United Kingdom. They will be backed up by development staff in Japan. We will commit to supporting the products for at least two years and will have more detailed plans on the products in the near future.

You may have noticed that we now have an interim web presence at <u>www.informatix.co.uk</u>, <u>www.piranesi.co.uk</u> and <u>www.microgds.co.uk</u>. These have been put together to give users access to all previous point releases and plug in files. Web shops and Distributor portals will be added in the future.

We can now take sales for the products directly from IFX in Japan with delivery by electronic download.
